BV20, RV63, RV66, RV69, Y26, YG25

Bubbles:

BV000, B000, G00, Y00, RV00, C1,
Colorless Blender

PRISMACOLOR PENCILS (Project #2):

I suggest using 6 pencils: white, light blue, green, yellow, dark pink, and black/dark blue.

If you want to match my colors exactly:

PC938 (white), PC1003 (spanish orange),
PC1102 (blue lake), PC913 (spring green),
PC994 (process red), PC901 (blue indigo),
optional: PC992 (light aqua)

Gather some small round objects to use to trace your bubbles (pill bottles, caps, etc.)
